

# PROMOTION TEMPLATE

## Northern Ireland Teachers' Council Recommends:

- **A Minimum Structure for Promotion in Primary Schools**
- **A Minimum Structure for Promotion in Secondary Schools**
- **The following limits re. Number of Vice-Principals:**

- There shall be a vice-principal in a Group 1 school with a unit total of 151 or higher;
- There shall be 2 vice-principals in a co-educational school in old Group 7, 8 or 9 or in a single sex school in Groups 10, 11 or 12;
- There shall be 3 vice-principals in a co-educational school in old Group 10, 11 or 12 or in a school in old Group 13;
- A fourth teacher may be paid as vice-principal in a school in old Group 14.

## Calculation of School Group and Unit Total

Schools are informed of their unit total and group by the Department of Education using the following formula:

The unit total of a school is calculated by reference to the number of pupils enrolled in the school, including pupils enrolled in nursery classes in primary schools. The calculation of the unit total is based on the ages of the pupils.

For each pupil under 14 years of age ...	count 2 units
For each pupil aged 14 and under 15 ...	count 4 units
For each pupil aged 15 and under 16 ...	count 5 units
For each pupil aged 16 and under 17 ...	count 7 units
For each pupil aged 17 and over ...	count 9 units

The exceptions are:

- (a) each pupils who attends for no more than half a day on each day for which he attends the school shall count half as many units as he would otherwise count.
- (b) each pupil with a statement of special educational needs shall count 3 units more than he would otherwise count.
