Membership cost – value for money

- The INTO subscription has been reduced to its lowest level in eight years, while maintaining service.
- The rate is just €25 per school year (September – August) for those in substitute positions who have qualified in the current or previous two school years.
- For other teachers in substitute positions (daily rate), the subscription is reduced to €85 per school year.
- For teachers working full hours in permanent or fixed-term posts, and paid on the salary scale, the cost is under €6.70 per week with three months' free membership on first joining.
