

Privacy Policy

Our Commitment to Privacy

Our Privacy Policy was developed as an extension of our commitment to combine the highest-quality products and services with the highest level of integrity in dealing with our members and the public. This Policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use and safeguard the personal information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our site and our products and services. This statement will be continuously assessed against new technologies, business practices and our members' needs.

What Information do we Collect?

When you visit our website you may provide us with two types of information:

- Personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis, and
- Statistical web site use information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse through our website(s).

Many of our interactive features require that you use your email address (for example when joining a mailing list) which is then stored in a file so that you are included in a list of recipients. We provide the same protections for these electronic communications that we employ in the maintenance of information received by mail and telephone.

If a User wishes to avail of our members section of the Site the information collected when the User signs up to the members section includes date of birth, teacher number, roll number and surname. The User consents where necessary to the passing on of their sign on information.

How do we use this Information?

Broadly speaking, we use personal information for the purposes of providing online services to members such as sending news, updates, notifications, press releases and so forth. Occasionally, we may also use the information we collect to notify you about important changes to our website and new services we think you will find valuable.

The channels of communication are developed and managed under our traditional trade union standards designed to safeguard the security and privacy of our members' personal information.

In addition, each communication includes an opt-out feature which enables you to remove your email address from our mailing list(s).

Similar to other websites, our website utilizes a standard technology called 'cookies' and Web server logs to collect information about how our website is used. Information gathered through cookies and Web server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our website, and the websites visited just before and just after our website. This information is collected on an aggregate basis. None of this information is associated with you as an individual.

Information collected assists us to design and arrange our web pages in the most user-friendly manner and to continually improve our website to better meet the needs of our members.

Sharing Information with partners and third parties,

Except as provided for in this Privacy Policy, we do not sell, share or otherwise disclose personal or website information with partners or third parties, unless the explicit consent of the User has been received.

Advertising

We may perform a statistical analysis of User behavior in order to measure interest in the various areas of our Site and to inform advertisers as to how many Users have seen or clicked their advertising banners. We may also use demographic and preference information to allow advertising banners on our Site be targeted, in aggregate, to the User from whom they are most pertinent. This means that Users may see advertising that is most likely to interest them, and advertisers may send their messages to people who are most likely to be receptive, improving both the User's experience and the effectiveness of the ads. In this statistical analysis and banner advertisement targeting, we will disclose information to third parties only in aggregate form. Personal information about you as an individual will not be provided to any third party without your consent.

Once we receive your transmission we make our best effort to ensure its security on our own system.

How Can You Access and Correct Your Information?

You may request access to all your personally identifiable information that we collect online and maintain in our database by emailing info@into.ie. In the vast majority of cases, this information will state that a particular email address is on a list of email recipients, or that an email address is on a database of email addresses which the online fora uses for authentication.

Legally Compelled Disclosure of Information

We may disclose information when legally compelled to do so; in other words, when we, in good faith, believe that the law requires it or for the protection of our legal rights.

Your Consent

By using our website you consent to our collection and use of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy. If we change our privacy policies and procedures, we will post those changes on our website to keep you aware of what information we collect, how we use it and under what circumstances we may disclose it.
