#### **New Entrant Pupils**

#### **Special Education Needs Allocation**

Under this allocation model, schools have been provided with an allocation for Special Education needs and Language Support. The provision of a profiled allocation was designed to give a fairer allocation for each school, recognising that all schools need an allocation for special needs support, including language support. A graduated allocation is provided which takes into account the actual level of need in each school. Under this allocation model, supports are provided immediately, based on each school's profile, to those pupils who need them without delay.

Further additional temporary Language Support may also be provided, as necessary, to schools that have a high concentration of pupils enrolled who have received less than 3 years EAL support but currently have less than B1 (level 3) proficiency in English.
