


Menopause and Teachers und of its people





The Teaching profession in the North

- GTCNI Digest of statistics 2018
- Over 75% female
- Over 25% 50+
- Approx 20% of teachers female and 50+
- Principal 60% female (DE 2020 62%)
- Almost 50% of female principals 50+
- Retirement ages have changed signficantly



Resolution Passed at INTO Northern Conference 2020

Conference acknowledges that a significant majority of the teaching profession are female and are therefore likely to go through the menopause at some stage in their teaching career.

Conference calls on Northern Committee:

- 1. To negotiate with management on a range of measures, including an agreed policy on supporting menopause in the workplace; and
- 2. To undertake a campaign on menopause in the workplace which focuses on supporting teachers.
