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










Primary Curriculum?


A "learning outcomes" approach needs to be incorporated into all curriculum statements at primary level (DES, 2011, Literacy and Numeracy, p.45)

We need to provide teachers with a clearer statement of the learning outcomes that we expect for children in English and Irish at each stage of the primary years and complement this with examples of children's work and learning that illustrate clearly what these learning outcomes mean in practice (p.49)

Over time, revise the required learning outcomes in subjects other than English, Irish and mathematics (p.57)
