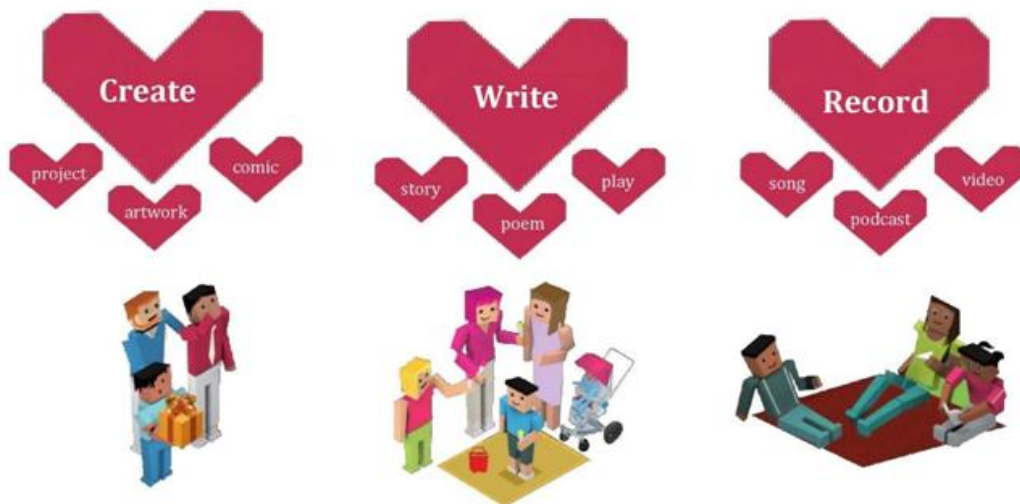


DIFFERENT FAMILIES, SAME LOVE COMPETITION

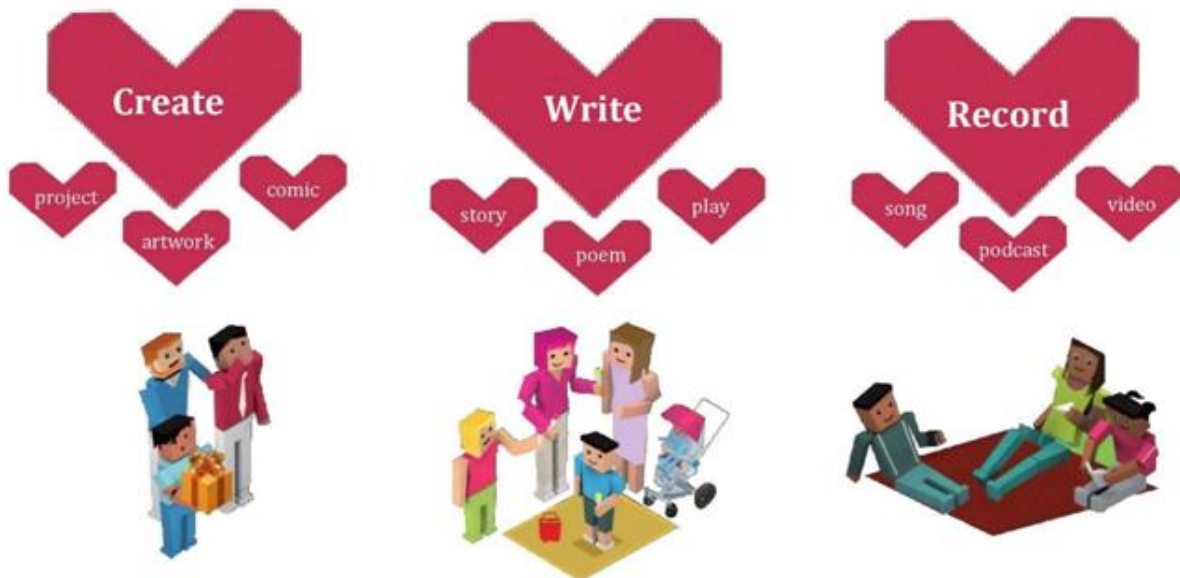

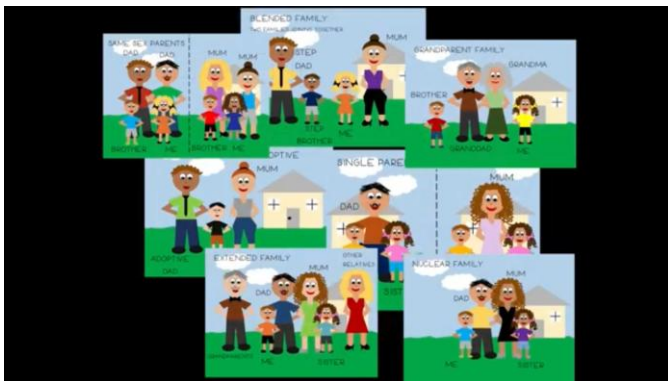

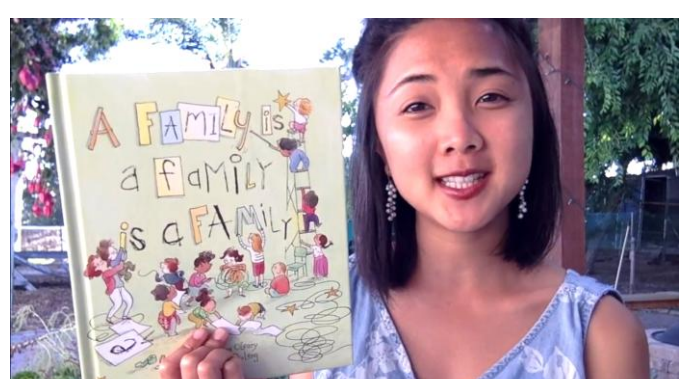
