**Graduate Certificate in the Education of Pupils on the Autism  
Spectrum (AS) for teachers working with Pupils on the AS in  
Special Schools, Special Classes or as Special Education  
Teachers in mainstream Primary and Post-Primary Schools,  
2021/2022**

**Introduction**

This programme will aim to provide substantial theoretical and practical professional development for teachers working with pupils on the AS and, thereby, will be in a position to contribute to the school's overall capacity in this area.

**The Programme 2021-2022**

In the school year 2021-2022 a Graduate Certificate in the Education of Pupils on the Autism Spectrum will be offered in DCU Institute of Education, DCU St Patrick's Campus, Drumcondra, Dublin 9. The Programme will run from September 2021 to early June 2022.

Deadline for applications is 11 March 2021.

Eighteen places are available in the Programme year 2021/2022.

**Funding**

Funding for the programme is provided by the Teacher Education Section of the Department of Education.



## Aim and Content

The aim of the programme will be to provide substantial theoretical and practical training for teachers working with pupils on the Autism Spectrum and, thereby, to contribute to the school's overall capacity in this area. A qualification of Graduate Certificate will be awarded by Dublin City University. Participants will be assessed on the basis of **full attendance** at the programme venue and **full participation** in the distance elements of the course, completion of selected tasks and written assignments and supervision of their work in school. Candidates are advised that recordings may be required for assignments. ## Duration and Organisation

The programme is one-year, part-time from September 2021 to June 2022, and consists of 5 modules. The course is delivered through distance learning modes, on-site learning at DCU Institute of Education, St Patrick's Campus and considers teachers' practical engagement with pupils in schools. The programme requires that participants are released from their schools for three weeks of the academic year.

The programme will include face-to-face tuition, tutorials and visits to other educational settings to observe examples of exemplary practice. The distance element of the course will include online synchronous and asynchronous engagement (course materials, online lectures and discussion fora).

## Covid-19

Applicants should be aware that HEIs may need to continue to operate under Covid-19 restrictions for the 2021/22 academic year which may necessitate amendments to the delivery of certain elements of the programme as required, in order to abide with the prevailing Government health advice at the time.

## Eligibility

Please note that all teachers must be registered in accordance with Section 31 of the Teaching Council Act, 2001-2015. Please refer to the Teaching Council's website [www.teachingcouncil.ie](http://www.teachingcouncil.ie) for further information.



This programme is for registered teachers who hold a post currently funded by the Department of Education and who are currently working with pupils on the Autism Spectrum or who will be working with pupils on the AS for the duration of the Programme in recognised Primary Schools including Special Schools and recognised Post-Primary Schools. The programme is designed specifically to assist teachers in meeting the learning and teaching needs of pupils on the AS. Potential applicants must therefore have a teaching role in relation to pupils on the AS.

#### Primary:

Teachers will be required to upload a copy of their Registration Certificate or Confirmation of Registration letter<sup>1</sup> from the Teaching Council, when submitting their application form. If the “Education Sector(s)” field is blank, teachers will be required to provide evidence that they have qualifications suitable to teach in either the mainstream primary sector or to teach pupils with Special Educational Needs.

Applicants from Primary Schools should have successfully completed their probationary period.

#### Post-primary:

Teachers will be required to upload a copy of their Registration Certificate or Confirmation of Registration letter (see footnote below) from the Teaching Council, when submitting their application form. If the “Education Sector(s)” field is blank, teachers will be required to provide evidence that they have qualifications suitable to teach in either the mainstream post-primary sector or to teach pupils with special educational needs in the post-primary sector.

Applicants from Post-Primary Schools should have successfully completed their Induction and Post Qualification Employment (PQE)

#### Special Schools:

Teachers will be required to upload a copy of their Registration Certificate or Confirmation of Registration letter (see footnote below) from the Teaching Council, when submitting their application form. If the “Education Sector(s)” field is blank teachers will be required to provide evidence that they have qualifications suitable to teach either in the mainstream primary or post-primary sectors or to teach pupils with special educational needs in the primary or post-primary sector or to teach in special school settings.

Applicants from Special Schools should have successfully completed their probationary period.

While teachers are completing this programme and for a reasonable period of time following completion of the programme, it is advised that school management make every effort to ensure that pupils on the Autism Spectrum continue to benefit from the teacher's knowledge and expertise in this area, through assigning the learning and teaching of pupils on the Autism Spectrum to the teacher concerned. Collaborative practices, such as team-teaching, can also form a part of these arrangements.

In order to participate in the programme, teachers will need access to a computer and the Internet.

Candidates should note that evidence of having completed Garda vetting is required for participation in the course.

### **Applications and Selection**

Applications from eligible candidates nominated by their school authorities are via online submission at [www.dcu.ie/ise/gceas](http://www.dcu.ie/ise/gceas).

Closing date for applications is March 11<sup>th</sup> 2021.

Normally, applications will be accepted from not more than one teacher per school who meets the requirements outlined in this Circular.

Applicants for this programme are not required to attend for interview.

### **Fees**

No fee or registration charges will apply for applicants eligible under the terms of this Circular.

### **Travel and Subsistence**

Travel and subsistence will be provided for any of the face-to-face elements of the programme in accordance with the Department of Finance Travel and Subsistence Circular 11/82. The updated travel and subsistence rates are recorded in Circular 13/2019 for Domestic Subsistence rates and Circular 05/2017 for Motor Travel rates. Please note for any travel and subsistence due under this Circular, the training rate is applicable.



### Extra Personal Vacation

No extra personal vacation will be allowed in respect of participation in this Course.

### Substitution

Substitution, which must be approved by the managerial authority of the school/ETB, will be allowed. The substitution must be deemed necessary to cover the approved periods of absence of the teacher from teaching duty for attendance at the course. Documentation from the college specifying the absence details must be retained by the school. **It should be noted that paid substitution cover will not be provided by the Department of Education where a teacher takes personal leave during the block release element of the Programme.**

### Salary Arrangements

All teachers on release from their school under the terms of this Programme will continue to receive their salary in the usual way.

Please note that successful completion of this Programme will not result in any entitlement to additional remuneration from the Department of Education.

### Master's Programme

On the successful completion of the Graduate Certificate in the Education of Pupils on the Autism Spectrum teachers may be eligible to apply for the Master of Education in Autism (M.Ed. in Autism) at the DCU Institute of Education.

Clár bliana, páirtaimseartha ó Mheán Fómhair 2021 go Meitheamh 2022, ina mbeidh 5 mhodúil, atá i gceist. Déantar an cúrsa a sholáthar trí mhodhanna cianfhoghlama, foghlaim ar an láthair ag Institiúid Oideachais OCBÁC, Campas Naomh Pádraig agus déantar rannpháirtíocht phraiticiúil múinteoirí le daltaí sna scoileanna a mheas. Éilíonn an clár go scaoiltear rannpháirtithe ó n-a scoileanna ar feadh trí seachtaine le linn na bliana acadúla.

Beidh teagasc aghaidh-ar-aghaidh, ranganna teagaisc agus cuairteanna chuig suíomhanna oideachais eile chun samplaí den bharrchleachtas a bhreathnú mar chuid den chlár. Nuair a bhíonn múinteoirí ar an gclár, agus ar feadh tréimhse réasunta tar éis críoch an chláir, moltar do bhainistíocht na scoile gach iarracht a dhéanamh lena dheimhniú go leanann an tairbhe do dhaltaí le hUathachas ó eolas agus saineolas an mhúinteora sa réimse seo, trí fhoghlaim agus teagasc dhaltaí le hUathachas a dháileadh ar an múinteoir atá i gceist. Is féidir cleachtais chomhoibritheacha, cosúil le teagasc-foirne, a bheith mar chuid de na socrúithe seo.

## **Ionadaíocht**

Ceadófar ionadaíocht, ach beidh gá le faomhadh údarás bhainistíochta na scoile/ an BOO. Caithfidh gá a bheith leis an ionadaíocht chun tréimhsí neamhláithreachta faofa an mhúinteora a chlúdach ó dhualgas teagaisc chun freastal ar an gcúrsa. Caithfidh an scoil doiciméid ón gColáiste ina luaitear na sonraí a choinneáil. Ba chóir a bheith san airdeall nach gcuirfidh an Roinn Oideachais agus Scileanna íocaíocht ionadaíochta ar fáil má ghlacann an múinteoir neamhláithreacht phearsanta nuair a bhíonn eilimint an bhlocscailte den Chlár ar bun.

## **Socrúithe Tuarastail**
