Every school that participates in the One Million Trees campaign received a free native Irish tree per classroom, together with access to age-appropriate lesson plans that can be used by teachers with their pupils.

This project provides schools with a pro-active educational intervention that resonates positively with the INTOs goal of Global Citizenship and Solidarity, while allowing schoolchildren to do something practical that responds to the climate change challenge.
